### Notes for candidates taking the Summer School modules for credit.

1. Summer School modules can be taken for credit on the following postgraduate programmes as follows:

#### Religion and Education Programme

- Post Primary

#### Religion and Culture Programme

- Theology and Philosophy in Dialogue
- Poetry and the Human Condition
- Ethics for Professionals

Summer School 1: Religion and Belief in a Secular Age

2. Applicants must meet the following programme entry requirements

#### General Admissions Requirements

- Applicants will normally hold an honours bachelor degree with a minimum of a second class honours grade two classification (2.2) and with academic subjects that pertain to the relevant Postgraduate programme.
- For admission to Programmes which are of a professional as well as an academic nature applicants must also hold a relevant professional qualification.
- An appropriate combination of non-degree qualifications and relevant professional experience may be accepted by a Programme Board as equivalent.
- The application process for admission to a postgraduate programme, or an element of such a programme, may include an interview. References must also be provided.
- Applications for admission are approved by the Registrar in consultation with the Chair of the relevant Programme Board and / or the programme / specialisation coordinator.

#### Specific Requirements for M.A. in Religion & Education

- The normal requirement for admission to the M.A. in Religion & Education is a 2.2 primary degree or equivalent.
- Theology or Religious Education or Religious Studies must be a major element of the primary degree.
- Applicants must hold a professional teaching qualification or have equivalent teaching experience.
- An interview will normally form part of the admission process. The selection criteria include: evidence of relevant academic pre-requisites, relevant work experience, motivation and general suitability for the programme.

#### Specific Requirements for M.A. in Religion & Culture

- The normal requirement for admission to the M.A. in Religion & Culture programme is a 2.2 primary degree or equivalent in an appropriate academic area of direct relevance to the programme.
- An interview will normally form part of the admission process. The selection criteria include: evidence of relevant academic pre-requisites, relevant work experience, motivation and general suitability for the programme.

3. Academic Transcripts:

A4 sized copies (no originals, please) of official transcripts for all qualifications listed must be included with the application. Mater Dei graduates are not required to include Mater Dei transcripts. If any award listed was in a different name from the name on this application, this must be stated. If an applicant is awaiting his/her final result, a transcript of the latest results achieved must be submitted. Transcripts in languages other than English must be accompanied by an English translation, together with a copy of the original certificate indicating the award. All translations must be done by a professional translator and certified as such.

4. English language standard.

In addition to meeting particular course requirements, applicants whose first language is not English, must submit evidence of a minimum standard of English equivalent to GCE A level, grade C.

5. Other Requirements

Incomplete applications cannot be considered. References may be sought in support of an application.
